The School of Architecture & Planning (SoAP) seeks to appoint three Associate Lecturers in the following sub-disciplinary fields:

- **1 in Architecture** – Sustainable design, urban design and resilience, ecology and the built environment, and knowledge of emerging digital technologies.
- **1 in Planning** – Planning tools and software (especially GIS and Autocad) and their application within Planning, and land use management.
- **1 in Architecture & Planning** – Experience in research, writing, editing, and publications in both the architectural and the planning fields, and with a vision of how SoAP should be contributing to the Gauteng region, South Africa, the continent, and the world at large.

We are seeking individuals who wish to develop an academic career within the South African Higher Education Environment. These are externally funded developmental posts and only open to South African applicants, with a focus on applicants from designated categories and especially those from a historically disadvantaged background.

**Qualifications and Experience:**

- Candidates must have a postgraduate degree (M Arch / MSc or equivalent) in either Architecture or Planning, with some experience in tutoring or providing other academic support activities being desirable.
- Professional experience in land use management in planning, and in sustainable environmental design practices in architectural practices is desirable.
- Experience in research collaboration and publication with scholars in different parts of the continent is desirable.
- Candidates must be willing to register for a further degree within the School, or at another equivalent institution approved of by the School.

**Duties:**

The appointees will be required to:

- Contribute to teaching in the School's degree programmes as well as participate and support the development of new and existing academic programmes.

- Conduct and publish research and promote knowledge exchange with South African non-academic stakeholders, as well as potentially supervise student research.
- Perform necessary administrative duties as required by the School.
- Assist the Head of School in coordinating research and publications at SoAP, and in coordinating development, professional and community outreach programs.
