



City of Johannesburg - SDF Review 2020/21 Preliminary Consultations

The SDF 2040 was approved in 2016 and as it has been 5 years, we will be reviewing it this financial year, 2020/21. As we have made significant additions and amendments to the SDF during the past 5 years (including the Inclusionary Housing Policy approved in 2019 and the Nodal Review approved this year) it will not be a full overhaul of the SDF, just an update. Provisionally, we plan to:

- Incorporate new policies approved since 2016,
- Update information on the status quo of the City,
- Report on the progress made in the past 5 years, and
- Address any limitations of the 2016 document.

To kick the process off, we are holding a preliminary round of public discussions under various themes/interest groups.

We hope to gain feedback and suggestions from interested parties on what we should consider in reviewing the SDF. We will then produce a draft that will be taken out for public participation.

We will be holding 5 sessions at the end of September, with the details included in the table below.
